



Hope for Wholeness Speaker Details

Thank you for your interest in Hope for Wholeness, and the possibility of a representative coming to speak at your church or group. We look forward to any opportunity of sharing the message of freedom from homosexuality through Jesus Christ.

The below information is the protocol of having a speaker or representative from Hope for Wholeness travel to speak at an event, church, or group. Please read over the information below and complete the online form. We encourage you to contact our office prior to completing the online form, and we encourage you to speak with the desired speaker or representative (if you have one in mind) prior to completing the online form.

Honorariums - Honorariums are paid to the visiting speaker, unless directed by the speaker. Honorariums are per speaker, per day, including travel time. Suggested honorarium rates: 100 persons or less—\$200-\$300; 101 to 500 persons—\$500-\$600; 501 or more—\$750-\$1000. If your congregation or group is not financially able to give at this rate, the speaker will join you in faith. The speaker simply asks that you do what you are able.

Love Offering - Whether in addition to an honorarium or in lieu of an honorarium, love offerings are always appreciated.

Travel expenses - Regardless of event's location, all travel expenses are to be covered above the honorarium and any love offering at 55 cents per mile, round-trip, if driving. If air travel is involved, then we ask that you reimburse the cost of the air fare (standard class acceptable). If an overnight stay will be involved, we ask that the hotel room be reimbursed. Whether your church/organization sets up/purchases airfare/hotel rooms in advance or reimbursed after the speaker secures is up to the two parties. As customary, any meals necessary in travel are requested to be reimbursed. Travel expenses are to be paid to the speaker. If a driving trip, travel expenses will be calculated for you and sent to you after we receive your completed information, as well as directions that we have to confirm best travel.

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Preparation for a speaking Engagement:

What has been shared in the past? - It is important to know what will be/has been shared prior to the Hope for Wholeness representative(s) speaking on the subject of homosexuality. They will be sharing statements like, "No-one chooses to be homosexual." "Homosexuality is a choice, but the temptations are not. They were formed in early childhood from many contributing factors." We have comprehensive information available for sale in the form of books, DVDs and CDs, as well as free information in the form of articles available on our website under resources.

If you have a talk the week before, or talks in the recent past on homosexuality/ sexuality/ morality and it is available, we would ask that you would get that recording to the speaker in

advance. If you are going to do a sermon prior to the speaking engagement and or sharing that day, please send your notes for your sermon to Hope for Wholeness in advance of the engagement. For notes, email is the best way to send. Good communication will help the Hope for Wholeness representative prepare for your church or group.

Display - The Hope for Wholeness representative will come prepared with a display and literature to be placed on top of a 6' or 8' table that you will need to provide. The Hope for Wholeness representative should have a table cloth for either.

Church or Group Representative Request - Please provide a representative to make the speaker's travel and time as efficient as possible. We will ask that we be provided with a representative's cell phone number, as well as have the representative meet them at the door upon their arrival and assist them in any way needed. The representative should email or call the speaker in advance to introduce themselves.

Getting there - If Map Quest or GPS directions are not the best way to get there, please provide these in advance. For large campuses, please provide a site map of the campus and mark where the event is taking place.

Notes for Introduction - Please print out the biography of the speaker, and utilize this information for a proper introduction. Please feel free to share extemporaneously in addition to the biographical information.

Audio/video recordings - If the talk is going to be recorded, a copy on CD, DVD, or MP3 for our own use and distribution is part of the speaking agreement. If both audio and video are being recorded, then one of each is requested. If video, and a DVCPRO (or higher) is being used, we would ask for a copy at this level.

Rights to recordings - Hope for Wholeness and the speaker themselves holds the rights to each of its speaker's content; these rights cannot be signed or agreed away. Churches may utilize these recordings for their own purposes, but cannot hold back recordings or keep Hope for Wholeness or the speaker from utilizing them for their own purposes as well. Beyond normal church distribution, an agreement with Hope for Wholeness and the speaker must be reached for distribution. This will be a separate agreement that must be arranged with Hope for Wholeness and the speaker in advance of any recordings.
